Junior Nisha Gudal won two events in tonight's 144-37 victory against the Ypsilanti Grizzlies at the Huron Ratorium, as she earned coveted first place points in both the 50 Free (30.72) and the 500 Free (6:32:50). Scoring along with her in the 50 free were juniors Anik Clement in 2nd (31.29) and Helen Miller (31.54). in 4th place. Taking 3rd and 4th in the 500 were junior Emma Pastula (6:55:42) and sophomore Hannah Frazier (7:27:95). Miller also won the 100 Fly event (1:17:51), followed by freshman Elaina Baker in 2nd (1:21:35), and junior Ani Weiss (1:24:28) in 3rd place.

Sophomore Katy Stegemann took home her first 1st place honor with her win in the 200 Free (2:22:91), with sophomores Lynsey Kingma (2:35:34) in 3rd and Giselle Roca (2:38:18) in 4th. Sophomores Spring Gao (2:43:31) and Neerja Garikipati (2:46:73) came in 1st and 2nd in the 200 IM, with Weiss (2:52:09) in 3rd place. Gaining her first dual meet event win, sophomore Sara Mattson swam a personal best 1:07:16 in the 100 Free, and was joined on the podium by Roca (1:13:35) in 2nd and freshman Anisha Laddha (1:25:02) in 3rd.

In the 100 Backstroke, junior Kate Monnett (1:17:94) took top honors, with Garikipati (1:21:49) in 2nd and Clement (1:24:45) in the 3rd place spot, while in the 100 Breaststroke, Kingma took home 1st place (1:20:10), and sophomore Kayley Smith (1:38:41) was 3rd. All three River Rat relays featured strong swims, starting with the 200 Medley winners, senior Lucy Moran, freshmen Claire Deng and Sophie Flott, and junior Sarah Gargan (2:11:26), and the 2nd place squad, junior Annabelle St. Pierre and Alice Deng, Gao and Gudal (2:19:66).

The 200 Free relay (Senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre, junior Abby Dittmar, freshman Jewel Huang and junior Adela Baker), closing in on but still shy of their D1 state time, touched first in 1:45:31, with junior Anna Riegger, captain/senior Mary Claire Chamberlain, Kingma and freshman Laura Deng (1:51:98) finishing 2nd. Rounding out the evening, the 400 Free relay team of Huang and C. Deng, junior Keri Haddrill, and Gao (4:15:93) won 1st, followed by L. Deng, Flott, Mattson and Moran (4:22:03) in 2nd place.

On the diving board, sophomore Izzy Holcomb secured her fifth dual meet win with 242.80 points, and was joined in scoring points for the Rats by junior Georgia Plagens (224.90) and freshman Morgen Heisenbuettel (204.50). Senior Katherine Wardner finished 4th in point total (181.40).

Huron vs Pioneer

Swim meets do not get much tighter than this evening's contest between long-time cross-town rivals the Huron River Rats and the Pioneer Pioneers. The points flew back and forth all evening, and the final result came down to the Rat's crucial "A" squad victory and "B" squad 3rd place in the 400 Free Relay. It was a great night for swimming all around. Three swimmers took two events each. Huron's freshman standout Jewel Huang won the 200 IM (2:16:76), with teammate captain/senior Dany Kotlyar (2:21:83) taking 2nd. Huang also claimed victory in the 100 Back (1:03:60), while junior Anna Riegger (1:05:01) took 2nd, and senior Shely Redding (1:08:34) touched in 3rd place.

Huron's junior Kathy Pan had much to celebrate as well, as she won both the 200 Free (1:59:25), an event in which she shared point-scoring honors with senior/captains Anna Li Aguirre (2:05:55) in 3rd and Mary Claire Chamberlain (2:05:90) in 4th, and the 100 Free (54:01), in which junior Adela Baker (58:38) and Aguirre (58:44) clocked in 4th and 5th, respectively. Pioneer's Karen Zhang also took a pair of events, the 100 Fly (59:71), and the 100 Breast (1:06:54), swimming Division 1 State cut times in both.

Huron's depth was evident even in those events, however, as in the 100 Fly, freshman Laura Deng (1:03:42) was 2nd, Riegger (1:05:09) was 4th, and Redding (1:06:29) touched in 5th; and in the 100 Breast, Huron swimmers were 2nd, (Kotlyar, 1:10:56), 3rd (L. Deng, 1:12:11), and 5th (senior Sarah Wang, 1:17:26). In the sprint 50 Free, A. Baker (25:80) was just touched out by Pioneer's Brianna Coury (25:69), but junior Abby Dittmar (26:04) handily claimed 3rd, and in the distance 500 Free, won by Pioneer's Carly Nadeau (5:32:10), Dittmar (5:34:82) was 2nd, with freshman Claire Deng (5:44:47) earning 4th place points.

River Rat Divers performed well against the strong Pioneer squad, led by Christina Lu. Sophomore Izzy Holcomb dove for 2nd place with 235.65. Junior Georgia Plagens scored 202.20 for 5th place. In her final home meet, Senior Katherine Wardner took 7th place with 177.95 points, while freshman Morgen Heissenbuettel came in 9th with a score of 128.05.

The signature moments of the evening came in the three relays. Pioneer opened by taking the 200 Medley Relay (1:55:32) by just .6 seconds over Huron's "A" group, (Huang, Kotlyar, Riegger and A. Baker), but Huron's "B" (Redding, C. Deng, L. Deng and Dittmar) won a key 3rd place victory in that event. And in the 200 Free Relay, Pioneer won again by a hair, 1:43:94 to Huron's 1:44:11, swum by Aguirre, A. Baker, L. Deng and Pan.

But it was the drama of the final event of the evening, the 400 Free Relay, that sealed Huron's victory and raised the rafters of the Ratatorium. The Rats and Pioneer were racing neck-and-neck through the first two swimmers, for Huron, Aguirre and Huang, and for Pioneer, Julia Pollock and Jodi Hawk, when Dittmar dove in and fought fiercely for her lead, swimming a personal best split of 56:40, and turning the momentum towards Huron. Pan then swam an amazing and confident final leg (53:69), giving Huron the victory (3:45:87), again just narrowly missing their Division 1 State Cut time. The "B" team of Chamberlain, juniors Sarah Gargan, Alice Deng, and Riegger cruised to 3rd place (4:02:46) and with those critical points, the Rats came out on top.

The victory was especially sweet, as the River Rats observed Senior Night festivities, and honored seniors, Chamberlain, Aguirre, Kotlyar, Wang, Lucy Moran, Safire Perea, Shely Redding, German exchange student, Hannah Rathje, and Katherine Wardner.

Huron vs Skyline October 14th, 2014

Last night at Skyline the River Rats faced a very strong Skyline in a meet that raised awareness for Ovarian Cancer. While the Rats lost the meet, they had some great swims. For one, both Free Relay teams achieved their previously elusive D1 State Cuts. In the 200 Free relay, junior Adela Baker, senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre, and juniors Abby Dittmar and Kathy Pan came in at 1:42:81, just behind Skyline's "A," but good enough to earn a berth at the State Championships at EMU in late November, and in the 400 Free Relay, freshman Jewel Huang, with Aguirre, Dittmar and Pan touched at 3:45:02, earning their State qualification.

Huron excelled in several events. Huang won the 100 Back in 1:01:93, and senior Shely Redding was 4th (1:08:12), and senior/captain Dany Kotlyar won the Breaststroke in 1:10:48, followed by freshman Laura Deng (1:11:34) in 3rd, and junior Anna Riegger (1:15:81) in 5th. Baker came in a hair short in the 50 Free (25:69) for 2nd place and Pan, in a very busy evening, took 2nd in both the 200 IM (2:11:45) and the 100 Free (54:68).

Huron Divers had a terrific night, as the very consistent sophomore Izzy Holcomb dove for 1st with 250.15 points, and junior Georgia Plagens scored 235.10, a personal best that earned her 2nd place honors. Senior Katherine Wardner came in 6th with 183.75 points, and freshman Morgen Heisenbuettel scored 171.40 for 7th place.

Huron vs Saline & Brighton

October 23rd, 2014

The hard-working Huron River Rats lost to both Saline (134-52) and Brighton (107-73) in their last regular meet of the season, but can celebrate some truly bright spots in the meet as they look towards the post-season.

Diver sophomore Izzy Holcomb scored a personal best (260.05 points) in her 3rd place finish, and swimmer junior Kathy Pan continued to add laurels to her excellent season in two great races. Pan was 2nd to Brighton's Taylor Seaman in the 100 Free (55:08), and 2nd overall in the 100 Breast (1:08:77), only .4 seconds behind Saline's Sophie Brightman. Junior Anna Riegger touched at 1:04:50 in the 100 Fly, 2nd to Brighton's winner, Lilia Staszal (1:00:73), and in the 200 Free, senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre swam a very fast 2:04:30, only .05 seconds behind Saline's Olivia McKelvey for an overall 4th place.

By far, the Rats' best overall showing was in the 100 Back, as powerful freshman Jewel Huang (1:03:20), finished 2nd, with Riegger (1:05:65) in 4th and senior/captain Dany Kotlyar (1:06:10) in 5th.

Finally, in the 200 Medley Relay, Huron's "A" (Huang, Kotlyar, Riegger and Pan) finished just behind Brighton's team, touching in 1:55:66 to Brighton's 1:54:98, and in the 200 Free Relay, the Rats' "A", (Pan, senior Shely Redding, Aguirre, and junior Adela Baker), again, were just touched out, swimming in 1:46:19, and just losing to Saline (1:45:95).

The Rats, together with swim coaches Andrea Stanczyk and JZ Zakrajsek, and dive coach Brad Huttenga look forward to their return to Saline on Friday, November 7th for the SEC Regional meet.

SEC Championship Prelims November 7th, 2014

Saline played host to the six SEC Red swim/dive teams yesterday at noon for the SEC Red Regional Swim/Dive finals, and the River Rats were on their game. Memorable swims were many, beginning with the meet's opening 200 Medley Relay where both the Rats' "A" (freshman Jewel Huang, senior/captain Dany Kotlyar, and juniors Anna Riegger and Adela Baker) and "B" (senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre, freshman Laura Deng, senior Shely Redding, and freshman Elaina Baker) scored in the top 8. The "A" touched in 1:53:07 for 4th, and the "B" in 1:56:84 for 6th.

Junior Abby Dittmar continues to drop time in the 200 Free, where she finished 5th in 1:59:38, while senior captain Mary Claire Chamberlain finished 10th (2:01:89), Aguirre, 11th (2:02:18) and sophomore Kirby Gardner, 15th (2:08:42). Junior Keri Haddrill dropped 9 seconds to finish 24th (2:14:90) and earn an invitation to today's finals.

In the 200 IM, Huang was 7th (2:16:29), and Kotlyar, 14th (2:24:73). Four other Rats scored top 24 and will be back today: junior Alice Deng in 17th (2:26:13), senior Sarah Wang in 18th (2:28:57), E. Baker, 20th (2:28:78), and junior Sarah Gargan, 22nd (2:30:16). A. Bakertouched in 4th in the 50 free (25:40), and sophomore Lynsey Kingma in 20th (27:58).

In the 100 Fly, Riegger earned the highest individual placing of the day for the Rats, with a 2nd place (1:00:87). Teammates Redding (10th in 1:03:29) and L. Deng (tied for 11th in 1:03:41), also placed, while Gargan (17th in 1:09:81) and junior Helen Miller (tied at 22nd in 1:14:59) will also compete today. Junior Kathy Pan was 4th (54:90) in the 100 Free, with Dittmar (6th in 55:26) swimming yet another personal-record-breaking swim. Other Huron 100 Free finalists were Aguirre, 13th (56:67), and Chamberlain, 15th (57:51).

In the distance 500 Free event, A. Baker swam for 8th (5:30:55), with freshman Claire Deng in 13th (5:39:65), and Gardner just touching out Saline's Samantha Fitch for 14th (5:44:45). Also returning today in exhibition in the 500 free will be A. Deng (17th in 5:51:27), Haddrill (19th in 6:04:37), junior Annabelle St. Pierre, (21st in 6:07:79), and junior Ani Weiss (22nd in 6:11:03).

SEC Championship Prelims

November 7th, 2014

Huron's "A" 200 Free relay of Dittmar, L. Deng, Kathy Pan and A. Baker finished 6th (1:43:66), and their "B" (Kotlyar, Wang, Gargan and Chamberlain) was 9th heading into today's competition.

The 100 Back was Huron's strongest event for the day, with six swimmers in top 16 spots. Huang was 6th (1:02:19), Riegger, 7th (1:02:49), Redding, 9th (1:05:87), E. Baker, 11th (1:06:08), freshman Sophie Flott, 12th (1:07:02), and sophomore Katy Stegemann, 14th in 1:07:35. Senior Lucy Moran finished 21st (1:10:79).

The 100 Breast will send Pan (4th in 1:09:73) and teammate Kotlyar (5th in 1:10:05) to the final heat today, with L. Deng (10th in 1:11:16) in the second heat, and Wang (17th in 1:15:66) and Kingma (24th in 1:19:15) to swim in the exhibition heat.

The day wrapped up with a team high 3:43:38 and 2nd place finish for the Rats' "A" squad in the 400 Free Relay (Dittmar, Huang, Aguirre, and Pan), and an 8th place finish for the "B", where Riegger, C. Deng, Chamberlain, and A. Deng came in at 3:52:52. Sophomore Kayley Smith will join the Rats in relay action today at Saline. The swimming competition begins at noon.

SEC Championship Finals

The Huron River Rats brought a full team to the SEC Red Finals Saturday at Saline's natatorium. Although they finished 4th and failed to catch Pioneer in what was a close meet for the "sister" teams, they have a lot to be proud of as they head to the State Championship. In all but one individual event, the 50 Free, Huron fielded four swimmers among the top 16 finalists.

Freshman Jewel Huang, continuing to break her own records, was 8th in the 200 IM (2:16:83), with senior/captain Dany Kotlyar in 12th (2:20:01), freshman Sophie Flott in 14th (2:22:74), and junior Alice Deng in 16th (2:29:96). Three swimmers also swam exhibition in this tough event: freshman Elaina Baker was 20th (2:27:10), senior Sarah Wang was 22nd (2:29:62), and junior Sarah Gargan touched in 23rd (2:33:61). Junior Abby Dittmar swam for 7th in the 200 Free (2:00:53), with senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre close behind in 11th (2:02:51), senior/captain Mary Claire Chamberlain in 12th, swimming her best ever 2:03:25, and sophomore Kirby Gardner, 15th (2:08:79). Junior Keri Haddrill was 24th (2:17:15). In the 50 Free, junior Adela Baker took an All-Conference Award with her 3rd place tie (25:25) with Saline's Lisa Gross, and sophomore Kayley Smith also represented Huron in the sprint; she was 22nd (27:22).

A. Baker finished 8th in the 500 Free (5:28:05), while freshman Claire Deng, 12th (5:38:24), junior Alice Deng, 14th (5:46:73), and Gardner, 15th (5:54:50) also scored points for the Rats in the event. Three other Huron swimmers swam in exhibition: junior Annabelle St. Pierre, 21st (6:04:22), junior Ani Weiss, 22nd (6:07:10), and Haddrill, 23rd (6:09:38). Junior Kathy Pan, always a Rat to watch, was 4th in the 100 Free (54:16). Dittmar, 7th (55:29), joined her in the finals, while Aguirre, 10th (56:05) and Chamberlain, 13th with a career-best 57:30, also put points on the board for Huron.

Junior Anna Riegger took 4th place honors in the 100 Fly (1:01:61), with senior Shely Redding in 11th (1:03:28), freshman Laura Deng, 13th (1:03:76), and junior Sarah Gargan, 15th in 1:10:36. Representing Huron for the first time at SEC's, junior Helen Miller was 23rd (1:15:63). In the 100 breaststroke, Kotlyar touched in 4th (1:09:42), Pan in 6th (1:10:17), L. Deng in 11th (1:11:84), and Wang in 15th (1:15:91). Sophomore Lynsey Kingma swam for 20th (1:16:54).

Huron's strongest event was the 100 Back, where seven swimmers came back for the SEC's 2nd day. Huang was 5th (1:01:13), Riegger, 7th (1:02:07), E. Baker, 10th (1:04:89), and Redding, 11th (1:05:50). In the exhibition heat, Flott finished 17th (1:05:63), sophomore Katy Stegemann, 18th (1:07:17), and senior Lucy Moran, 19th (1:08:49).

The Huron Relay teams had a great outing. The 200 Medley "A" (Aguirre, Kotlyar, Riegger and A. Baker) was 3rd (1:52:18), while the "B" (Huang, Redding, L. Deng, and E. Baker) swam for 11th (1:57:18). The 200 Free "A" (A. Baker, L. Deng, Gargan and Pan) was 4th (1:43:95), and the "B" (Dittmar, Kotlyar, Wang and Chamberlain), 12th (1:45:95). A third relay also competed (Gardner, St. Pierre, Haddrill, and Kingma). Finally, the 400 Free "A" squad (Dittmar, Aguirre, Riegger and Pan) swam a season-best 3:39:93 to take 3rd, and the "B" (Redding, Huang, C. Deng, and Chamberlain) finished 11th (3:53:18).

In the diving portion of the competition, sophomore Izzy Holcomb moved up 7 places from Friday, and finished a solid 7th place (349.90). Junior Georgia Plagens moved up 3 spots to 12th (311.30), and Senior Katherine Wardner, in her final high school diving competition, was 15th (263.30).

Ann Arbor Huron, Pioneer girls swim teams turn in top-20 finishes at D1 state meet

Saline wasn't the only team representing the strength of the Southeastern Conference this weekend at the Division 1 girls swim and dive state meet at Eastern Michigan University.

Ann Arbor Pioneer finished 15th with 65 team points, while Ann Arbor Huron came in 19th with 33 points.

Both coaches said they were happy with the way their girls competed and that the finishes were what was expected heading into the state meet. Last year, Pioneer finished 15th and the River Rats followed in 16th.

"We swam really well; the girls did what we needed to get into today," Huron coach Andrea Stanczyk said. "Times were a little slower than I think the girls wanted, but they did what they needed to do. Everyone swam what I thought they would."

Pioneer coach Eric Stanczyk echoed his peer, calling the meet a success, top to bottom. His team earned big points from diver Christina Lu, who finished third in the 1 meter diving with a score of 438.85.

Senior Karen Zhang contributed a second-place finish in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:02.85), and a third-place finish in the 100-yard fly (55.62).

The Pioneers finished 14th in both the 200-yard medley relay (1:50.17) and the 400-yard free relay (3:38.41).

Huron was led by junior Kathy Pan, who came in eighth in the 200 IM (2:08.59) and 14th in the 100-yard breaststroke (1:07.97). She also helped the team to a 16th place finish in the 200-yard free relay (1:40.58).

The River Rats divers, Izzy Holcomb and Georgia Plagens, finished 12th and 13th.

Huron Men's Water Polo Team

Water Polo State Tournament November 14th, 2014

Holden Tamblyn had five goals for the Ann Arbor Huron boys water polo team as it used a seven-point second quarter to top Zeeland East/West 13-8 in a state championship quarterfinal on Friday.

“We were actually playing pretty well then,” Zeeland coach Davae Vrugink said. “In the second, we got our offense going, but they kept scoring right after us. We locked down on defense after that, but I have to hand it to Huron -- they played a great game.”

Micah DeJonge led Zeeland with four goals. “DeJonge played a great game and there was no quitting with him,” Vrugink said. “He kept coming in and trying to make it happen. He’s leading goal scorer for a reason.”

Goalkeeper Jared Leetsma had 10 saves, and made a shot from the goal to score. “It was an awesome full-court shot,” Vrugink said. “Their goalie was sneaking out a bit, and we have a set play for that. I yelled out the words and he made it happen.”

It was the second time in the season Leetsma successfully scored from the goal. “It’s about technique,” Leetsma said. “A lot of good technique. In practice we work on his passing, and his placement. It’s just about placement.” Curtis Berens, Tristan Geschwendt and Gabe Trevino each also had a single goal. “This team has been a lot of fun to coach,” Vrugink said. “Even when we were down at half, they just didn’t give up, and as a coach that makes you very, very proud.”

Zeeland will play Ann Arbor Skyline for a fifth place spot on Saturday. The team’s previous best finish at the state championship was seventh in 2012. “They’re a similar team to us with a lot of speed,” Vrugink said. “They move a lot on offense and that’s what we do too. They’ve got a lot of really great outside shooters.”

Water Polo State Tournament

November 14th, 2014

It took two overtimes but Hudsonville defeated Ann Arbor Huron 10-9 on Saturday afternoon in the semi-finals to advance to tonight's championship game.

"It was definitely a hard fought game," said Hudsonville coach Joe Szymanski. "Huron was a physical team and we play similar styles. Our goalie played exceptional as always."

Jason Dalman led Hudsonville with four points including two goals and two assists. He assisted on the game-winning goal scored by Noah Beyer in the second overtime period.
