L ight area girls' swim/dive teams competed yesterday evening at the Ann Arbor Huron Ratatorium for the annual Huron Relays. The excitement of the first competition of the season was evident, and more than one parent remarked that the noise level rivalled that of a Justin Bieber concert.

The eight teams included AA Huron, AA Skyline, AA Pioneer, So. Lyon, Saline, Brighton, Dexter and Northville. While Saline took first place with 468 points, only 42 points separated the 2nd (AA Skyline with 370) from the 5th place teams (AA Huron/AA Pioneer, tied at 328), promising an exciting season of swim/dive action in Southeast Michigan.

The Huron River Rats started out the meet with a powerful 2nd place finish in the 200 Medley Relay, featuring senior/captains Anna Li Aguirre and Dany Kotlyar, and juniors Anna Riegger and Adela Baker. Their 1:53:75 time earned them a D1 state cut. The "B" 200 Medley Relay team (senior Shely Redding, freshman Jewel Huang, senior Sarah Wang and freshman Elaina Baker) also finished 2nd in their heat (2:02:26).

Both Huron teams again looked strong in the 200 Breaststroke Relay, with the "A" squad (Kotlyar, freshman Laura Deng, junior Annabelle St. Pierre, and Wang) finishing 4th (2:18:81), and the "B" (juniors Alice Deng and Kate Monnett, with sophomores Katy Stegemann and Spring Gao) clocking in a very close 2nd (2:31:66) to Saline's winning relay (2:31:35).

In the Diving Event, sophomore standout Izzy Holcomb, together with freshman Morgen Heisenbuettel took 2nd place.


The Swimming Rats are coached for a second year by Andrea Stanczyk with long-time assistant JZ Zakjrasek, while Brad Huttenga continues to coach the divers in perpetuity. The team will be led on deck by captains Kotlyar, Aguirre and senior Mary Claire Chamberlain. With the addition of a strong group of freshmen, the aquatic year is looking bright for the River Rats.

Huron vs Hartland September 3rd, 2014

Ithough it was just the first dual meet of the season, the Huron's Girls' Swim & Dive Team looked strong and confident tonight with their decisive 112-74 win over Hartland. Congratulations are in order for junior Kathy Pan, who added two State Cuts to her resume, in the 100 Free (54.35) and the 200 IM (2:13:28); and for captain/senior Dany Kotylar, who secured a State Cut with her win in the 100 Breast (1:08:99).

The meet opened with two strong 200 Medley relay teams taking 1st (junior Anna Riegger, Kotlyar, freshman Laura Deng and junior Adela Baker) in 1:57:22 and 3rd (senior Shely Redding, freshman Jewel Huang, senior Sarah Wang and junior Abby Dittmar) in 2:04:18. Senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre won the 200 Free easily with her MISCA cut time of 2:05:60, followed by senior/captain teammate Mary Claire Chamberlain in 2nd (2:09:13).

The Rats dominated the IM with Pan's win, and Huron swimmers in 2nd --Huang (2:18:62) and 3rd --Kotylar (2:20:52). In the 50 Free, juniors Dittmar (MISCA cut time of 26.50) and A. Baker (26.70) earned 2nd and 3rd place berths, while Riegger (1:03:27) and L. Deng (1:05:17) dominated the 100 Fly in 1st and 2nd, with Wang (1:13:79) adding to her point total with a 5th place finish.

Huron also scored three top 5 swimmers in the 100 Free, Pan, A. Baker (59.23) in 4th and Chamberlain (59.80) in 5th. Freshman Claire Deng came in an impressive 2nd in the 500 Free (5:48:81), and both the "A" and "B" 200 Free Relays made MISCA cuts, Baker, Aguirre, Dittmar, and Pan, 2nd (1:45:10), and L. Deng, Wang, Chamberlain and Kotlyar, 3rd (1:50:59).

Huang (1:04:42), Riegger (1:04:72), and Aguirre (1:05:46) were 2, 3 and 4 in the 100 Back, and Kotylar, with her State Cut, L. Deng (1:13:72), and Wang (1:17:98) went 1, 2, 3 in the 100 Breast. In the final event of the night, the 400 Free Relay, both Huron "A" (Riegger, Chamberlain, Dittmar, and Pan) and "B" (Huang, junior Sarah Gargan, freshman Sophie Flott, and C. Deng) again earned MISCA cuts with their respective 1st place (3:52:31) and 3rd place (4:06:49) finishes.

In the Diving category, the River Rats also had a strong season start, with three of the four divers scoring personal bests: senior Katherine Wardner in 5th (185.60), junior Georgia Plagens in 3rd (208.90), and sophomore Izzy Holcomb 1st on the podium with a career high of 257.95 points. Freshman Morgen Heisenbuettel, diving in her first ever high school meet came in 7th, with a score of 167.25.

Huron vs Dexter September 6th, 2014

he River Rats faced a fast, deep team of Dreadnaughts on Saturday, Sept. 6, losing 127-59. In the swimming portion of the meet, no events went Huron's way, beginning with the 200 Medley Relay, where the Huron "A" (captain/senior Anna Li Aguirre, Junior Kathy Pan, captain/senior Dany Kotlyar and junior Abby Dittmar), touching at 1:57:89 was just edged out of 2nd place by Dexter's "B" squad (1:57:20).

Individual 2nd place finishers for the Rats included Kotlyar in the 100 Fly (1:06:20) and Pan in the 50 Free (26.06). Pan was also 3rd in the 100 Breast (1:10:31), followed by Kotlyar in 4th (1:11:08) and junior Anna Riegger in 5th (1:14:90). Junior Adela Baker took two 3rd place finishes, in the 200 Free (2:09:01) and the 100 Free, where she earned her MISCA cut (58.16). Riegger also earned her MISCA cut in the 200 IM (2:20:71) with a 3rd place finish.

Both Free Relays swam MISCA times and were strong enough to take 2nd over Dexter's "B" squads. The 200 Free line-up (Baker, freshman Laura Deng, Dittmar, and Pan) clocked in at 1:48:24, and the 400 Free squad (Baker, captain/senior Mary Claire Chamberlain, freshman Jewel Huang and Dittmar) easily bested Dexter's "B" with a time of 4:02:31.

The real celebration for the day, however, came in the diving well, where all four River Rat divers rocked the meet. Sophomore Izzy Holcomb, in her second dual meet win in three days, scored an impressive 257.20 points. Junior Georgia Plagens was 2nd with a personal best score of 214.05. Also diving for her personal best score was Freshman Morgen Heissenbuettel, (171.85) with senior Rat Katherine Wardner in 5th with a total of 169.80 points. Huron Women's swim & Dive Team



Y esterday evening the Huron River Rats showed their tenacity with an exciting win over So. Lyon, 95-91. On the swimming side, the Rats revealed great depth and strong performances by this year's freshmen.

Although the opening 200 Medley Relay "A" team of senior/captains Anna Li Aguirre and Dany Kotlyar, and juniors Anna Riegger and Adela Baker (1:56:56) was disappointingly just touched out by So. Lyon (1:56:10), the 200 Free Relay, swum by Junior Kathy Pan, freshman Laura Deng, and juniors Abby Dittmar and Baker (1:45:89), proved an easy three-seconds-to spare win over So. Lyon.

Continuing their excellence in Breaststroke, the Rats went 1, 2, 3 in the 100 Breast— Pan (1:09:49); L. Deng (1:12:80) and freshman Jewel Huang (1:14:66); and the 200 IM: Huang (2:17:45); Kotlyar (2:21:58); and L. Deng (2:21:85). In the 100 Back, junior Anna Riegger (1:04:44) had a comfortable win, with teammate senior Shely Redding (1:09:38) in 3rd, and in the 100 Fly, Riegger (1:04:39) and Kotlyar (1:06:31) took 2nd and 4th respectively.

In the Freestyle events, Huron excelled, as 1st and 3rd place honors went to Pan (2:01:06) and senior/captain Mary Claire Chamberlain (2:10:08) in the 200, and Baker (26.32) and Dittmar (26.41) swam for 2nd and 3rd in the 50, as did Dittmar (57.29) and Chamberlain (1:00:58) in the 100. Aguirre was 2nd in the 500 (5:35:22), just behind So. Lyon's Emily Kososki (5:34:41).

All four Huron divers dove well against the strong South Lyon team. Sophomore Izzy Holcomb came in 2nd with a score of 242.20. The rest of the dive team all tried new dives at the meet, boosting their scores with higher degrees of difficulty. Junior Georgia Plagens, trying out Dive 5132D, a forward 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ somersault 1 twist (D.D. 2.2), took 4th with 205.80, while Senior Katherine Wardner executed a 403C, an inward 1 1/2 somersault, (D.D. 2.2) and dove for 7th place and Freshman Morgen Heissenbuettel debuted a 105, a front 2 1/2 somersault (D.D. 2.4) and ended in 8th, with 166.55 points.



Lt certainly will not be the last pool record that sophomore diver Izzy Holcomb breaks as a Rat, but it was her first. Yesterday evening in Jackson, with a score of 245.95, Holcomb won the diving event and broke the Jackson pool record for points in a dual meet. The record had been previously held by Huron alum Molly Gelb. Huron divers also took the 3rd and 4th spots, with junior Georgia Plagens scoring 199.4 and senior Katherine Wardner earning 172.25. Diving in exhibition, freshman Morgen Heissenbuettel scored 134.1.

In the swimming events, Huron dominated as well. They opened by winning the 200 Medley Relay (senior Shely Redding, senior/captain Dany Kotlyar, junior Kathy Pan, and freshman Laura Deng) in 2:00:60, and placing 3rd with the "B" squad (freshmen Jewel Huang and Claire Deng, junior Adela Baker, and senior/captain Mary Claire Chamberlain) in 2:06:71.

The 200 Free Relay "A" and "B" teams finished 1st and 2nd, with junior Abby Dittmar, captain/senior Anna Li Aguirre, and juniors Pan and Baker touching at 1:47:82, and juniors Anna Riegger, Alice Deng, Annabelle St. Pierre and sophomore Kirby Gardner clocking in at 1:55:21. Captain/senior Aguirre easily won the 200 IM (2:25:27), with teammate Dittmar in 3rd (2:33:94) and junior Sarah Gargan in 5th (2:38:79); Pan took 1st in the 100 Free (55.79), followed by Gardner in 4th (1:03:72); and Riegger handily won the 100 Breast (1:15:42), while freshman C. Deng finished 3rd (1:20:79), and junior Kate Monnett (1:24:58) took 5th place.

The Rats' Distance swimmers had a banner night, with L. Deng winning the 500 Free (5:43:57), followed by Kotlyar (5:56:25) in 2nd and sophomore Katy Stegemann (I6:31:25) in 4th. The Rats also scored three swimmers in the 200 Free with Riegger (2:08:62) in 2nd, A. Deng (2:17:80) in 3rd and junior Helen Miller (2:41:89) in 5th place. In the 100 Back, Freshmen Huang (1:03:46) and Sophie Flott (1:11:28) were 2nd and 3rd, while Baker (1:07:31), Redding (1:08:70) and St. Pierre (1:17:00) swam to 2nd, 3rd and 5th place finishes in the 100 Fly.

In the evening's closing event, the 400 Free Relay, both "A" and "B" teams brought in points for the Rats with Dittmar, L. Deng, Baker and Pan in 1st (3:57:33) and Kotlyar, Flott, Gargan and freshman Elaina Baker (4:20:40) in 3rd. When everything was tallied, Huron was the victor by a score of 113-73.

Huron vs Ypsilanti Lincoln September 18th, 2014

he River Rats traveled to Ypsilanti Lincoln yesterday evening to compete against a small, but enthusiastic and welcoming Lincoln team. Lincoln's Emma Kellerman took 1st in Diving (220.40), with Huron's junior Georgia Plagens (203.70) in 2nd, senior Katherine Wardner (181.25) in 3rd, and freshman Morgen Heissenbuettel (126.06) in 4th, but the Rats won every swimming event.

The 200 Medley Relay "A" (senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre, junior Anna Riegger, senior/captain Dany Kotlyar, and junior Abby Dittmar) came in at 2:01:31, with the "B" (senior Shely Redding, junior Kate Monnett, and freshmen Laura Deng and Elaina Baker) in 2nd place, with a time of 2:11:13. Junior Adela Baker won the 200 IM (2:30:08) with freshman Sophie Flott close behind (2:31:47). Freshman Jewel Huang easily won the 50 free (26.96), and junior Sarah Gargan (28.97) took a close 2nd place. The 200 free saw Rats in 1st (sophomore Kirby Gardner in 2:19:25), 2nd (senior Sarah Wang in 2:22:41), and 3rd (junior Ani Weiss in 2:30:84), as did the 100 Free, with L. Deng (58.17), Aguirre, (58.81) and junior Alice Deng (1:03:15) clocking in in turn, and the 500 Free, where Riegger (5:35:18), Dittmar (5:44:46), and E. Baker (6:22:65) did the job for Huron. L. Deng and Riegger both logged in MISCA cuts for those events.

The Rats also dominated the 100 Fly, where junior Kathy Pan (1:04:03) swam to 1st and a MISCA cut, followed by Redding (1:08:03) and senior/captain Mary Claire Chamberlain (1:10:45), and in the 200 Freestyle Relay, where the "A" (A. Baker and A. Deng, Wang, and Huang) touched at 1:52:59, while the "B" (Flott, Gardner, sophomore Spring Gao, and Gargan) swam to 2nd in 1:57:85, and the "C" (sophomores Katy Stegemann and Giselle Roca, and juniors Nisha Gudal and Helen Miller) took 3rd in 2:09:14. Senior Lucy Moran won the 100 Back (1:11:33), with freshman Claire Deng in 3rd (1:13:65) and junior Annabelle St. Pierre (1:14:90) in 4th, and Kotlyar pulled a 1:12:29 in the 100 Breast for 1st place, while teammate junior Emma Pastula also scored points for the Rats with her 4th place finish (1:34:47).

To close out the meet, in the 400 Freestyle Relay, Pan, Wang, sophomore Kayley Smith and Chamberlain were victors (4:11:17), with Weiss, junior Keri Haddrill, sophomore Neerja Garikipati, and Stegemann (4:33:64) finishing 2nd.



he Huron Girls' Swim/Dive Team won a decisive SEC Conference victory yesterday evening against visiting Temperance/Bedford. While the Bedford swimmers put in some strong performances, especially Lexi Marok, who won the 100 Breast (1:13:35) and the 200 IM (2:29:13), they were no match for the Rats overall.

Huron opened by taking the 200 Medley Relay easily, with freshman Jewel Huang, junior Kathy Pan, and senior/captains Dany Kotlyar and Anna Li Aguirre finishing in 1:56:11. The "B" relay of freshman Laura Deng. senior Sarah Wang, junior Adela Baker and freshman Sophie Flott were 3rd (2:09:80). Junior Anna Riegger cruised to victory in the 200 Free (2:06:69), with captain/senior Mary Claire Chamberlain (2:09:23) in 3rd and junior Sarah Gargan (2:17:38) in 4th . And while Bedford's Marok did win the 200 IM, junior Alice Deng was only .18 seconds behind with her 2nd place time of 2:29:21, followed by three Rats in succession after her: junior Annabelle St. Pierre (2:36:23) in 3rd , sophomore Katy Stegemann (2:36:34) in 4th , and senior Lucy Moran (2:40:78) in 5th .

In the 50 Free, Baker claimed 1st place (25.85), with Riegger (27.00) in 3rd , and in the 100 Fly, Kotlyar (1:05:02), Aguirre (1:07:18), Flott (1:12:25) and freshman Claire Deng (1:20:89) swam to 2nd , 3rd , 4th and 5 th places. Both the 100 and 500 Free races went handily to Huron. L. Deng swam a 58.30 in the 100, with St. Pierre (1:04:64) in 3rd and sophomore Kayley Smith (1:05:35) in 4th , and Pan earned her MISCA cut and another victory in the 500 (5:28:51), with Baker (5:40:18) in 2nd , and Chamberlain (5:46:09) in 3rd . Two Deng sisters scored in the 100 Back, L. Deng in 1st (1:09:30) and A. Deng (1:14:25) in 5th , and in the 100 Breast, the Rats went 2, 3, 4, with Wang (1:19:39) in 2nd , C. Deng (1:19:66) in 3rd , and Stegemann (1:21:82) in 4th .

In both Free Relays, Huron's "A" and "B" squads took 1st and 2nd . In the 200 Free Relay event, it was Huang, Aguirre, Riegger, and Pan , touching at 1:46:23, and Kotlyar, Gargan, Wang and C. Deng in 2nd (1:53:35), and in the final 400 Free Relay, Pan, Baker, L. Deng and Huang earned gold (3:54:74), with Chamberlain, Baker, L. Deng and Huang (3:58:57) swimming for silver.

On the diving board, sophomore Izzy Holcomb grabbed her fourth dual meet win of the season with a score of 256.50. Junior Georgia Plagens scored 201.60 for 3rd place, and senior Katherine Wardner, continuing to improve, dove for a personal best score with 194.50, landing in 4th . Freshman Morgen Heissenbuettel dove for 5th place scoring 164.50.

EGR Pioneer Classic Invite September 27th, 2014



A mong eight deep teams on the board and in the water, the River Rats took a confident 3rd place at this weekend's Pioneer Classic in East Grand Rapids. Sophomore Izzy Holcomb took center stage in a talented field of 35 divers, as her victorious 448 points qualifies her as an All-American. Completing 11 dives for the first time, Junior Georgia Plagens finished 7th (336.85), senior Katherine Wardner was 23rd (258.65) and freshman Morgen Heisenbuettel, also competing in her first 11-dive meet, scored 235.80 for 25th place.

Huron began the meet with a 2nd place in their 200 Medley Relay (senior/captains Anna Li Aguirre and Dany Kotlyar, and juniors Anna Riegger and Adela Baker), finishing in 1:55:79. The "B" squad also scored, ending in 15th in 2:05:30 (senior Shely Redding, freshman Laura Deng, senior Sarah Wang and freshman Elaina Baker). Junior Kathy Pan was 3rd in the 200 Free (2:00:19), with teammate junior Abby Dittmar in 14th (2:07:84).

The 200 IM also had two Huron swimmers in the top 20, freshman Jewel Huang, 7th in 2:17:84, and Aguirre (2:26:28) in 19th. Pan swam to a 6th place in the 100 Back (1:02:10), and was joined by Huang in 8th (1:02:97), Aguirre in 13th (1:05:13), and Riegger in 14th place (1:05:84). Another strong event for the Rats was the 100 Breast, as Kotlyar (1:10:78) narrowly missed 1st with her 2nd place swim, and L. Deng was close behind (1:11:85) in 6th, with Wang (1:17:64) touching in 18th place.

Four Rats excelled in the 100 Fly, L. Deng (1:04:72) in 10th, Riegger (1:04:97), just behind her in 11th, Kotlyar (1:07:37) in 16th, and Redding (1:08:41) in 20th. A. Baker was 9th in the 50 Free (26.04), Dittmar (57:45) placed 8th and A. Baker (59.63) 17th in the 100 Free, and freshman Claire Deng (5:51:14) swam to a 16th place finish in the distance 500 Free event.

Finally, in both the Freestyle Relays, Huron's "A" swam to impressive 5th place finishes. In the 200 Free Relay, Pan, Huang, Dittmar, and A. Baker clocked in at 1:45:01, while teammates Kotlyar, junior Sarah Gargan, Wang, and sophomore Lynsey Kingma finished 13th in 1:52:21. Then in the 400 Free Relay, Dittmar, Aguirre, L. Deng, and Pan touched in 3:50:34, with fellow Rats Riegger, C. Deng, Gargan and Huang (4:02:30) finishing in the 13th spot. Huron's total 291 points put them in a solid 3rd place, behind Farmington Hills Mercy (734), and East Grand Rapids (562), and ahead of Ann Arbor Pioneer (177).

Other Rats swimming in the meet included: freshman Sophie Flott, sophomores Katy Stegemann, Sara Mattson, Anik Clement, Giselle Roca, Hannah Frazier, Kirby Gardner, Lynsey Kingma, Kira Pierson, Kayley Smith, Spring Gao and Neerja Garikipati, and juniors Annabelle St. Pierre, Ani Weiss, Keri Haddrill, Nisha Gudal, Helen Miller, Kate Monnett and Emma Pastula.

Ann Arbor Huron scored another victory at home last night over Monroe, 145-40. Monroe's Samantha Myers won the 100 Fly (1:03:87), but Huron took every other event, and earned a number of MISCA cuts for next weekend's meet as well. The meet opened with a strong showing by both "A" (seniors Shely Redding and Sarah Wang, freshman Sophie Flott, and senior/captain Dany Kotlyar) and "B" squads (sophomore Katy Stegemann, freshman Claire Deng, junior Alice Deng, and freshman Elaina Baker), who took 1st (2:07:71) and 2nd (2:10:87) places respectively.

Sophomore Kirby Gardner recorded her first home meet 1st place in the 200 Free (2:19:64), with junior Sarah Gargan (2:20:45) just behind her, and sophomore Sara Mattson (2:28:34) in 4th. In the 200 IM, senior/captain Anna Li Aguirre earned her MISCA cut (2:22:47), while points were scored for the Rats by E. Baker (2:36:40), who won the event, with junior Annabelle St. Pierre (2:38:23), and senior Lucy Moran (2:40:97) following in 2nd and 3rd places. Huron went 1,2,3,4 in the 50 Free, scoring sophomore Kayley Smith (29:27), Stegemann (29.60), and junior Kate Monnett (30:64), with junior Keri Haddrill in 4th (31:27).

Captain Aguirre took home her second MISCA cut of the evening in the 100 Free (57:59), while Gargan (1:02:45) earned 1st in the event, with Flott (1:04:73) in 2nd, and sophomore Spring Gao (1:08:34) taking the 4th place points. The 500 Free saw two MISCA cuts, A. Baker (5:34:33) in 1st, and junior Abby Dittmar (5:36:54) in 2nd. Freshman Laura Deng (5:44:39) was 3rd, and freshman Claire Deng swimming in exhibition, touched in 4th (5:48:93). Huron's "A" 200 Free Relay (junior Kathy Pan, freshman Jewel Huang, junior Anna Riegger, and Aguirre) won in 1:45:45, and the "B" clocked in at 2nd (1:55:83), featuring senior/captain Mary Claire Chamberlain, St. Pierre, A. Deng and Gargan.

Three Rats dominated the 100 Back, Kotlyar (1:05:75) taking 1st with her MISCA-cut earning swim, Redding (1:08:45) in 2nd, and E. Baker (1:10:97) in 3rd.
